inscription (n)	a short dedication <b>written</b> in a book or engraved on something, such as a coin or monument
manuscript (n)	a piece of <b>writing</b> ; a book
postscript (n)	P.S.; a short bit of <b>writing</b> added after a letter is finished
prescription (n)	a piece of paper <b>written</b> by a doctor that lets you get medicine at the pharmacy
scribble (n)	sloppy <b>writing</b> that is hard to read
scribe (n)	a person who <b>writes</b> things down
script (n)	a set of papers with <b>writing</b> that will be read and acted out
subscription (n)	a <b>written</b> agreement to buy and read a magazine or newspaper for a set period of time
transcribe (v)	to <b>write</b> down or record; to translate
