bibliography (n)	the <b>written</b> list of all the books used in a report or book
biography (n)	a book <b>written</b> about a person's life
cartography (n)	mapmaking; the <b>writing</b> involved in making maps or charts
homograph (n)	a word <b>written</b> the same way as another word but having a different meaning (e.g., bow—hair and bow—ship)
paragraph (n)	a section of <b>writing</b> that has a topic and concluding sentence
phonograph (n)	record player; a device that turns the <b>writing</b> on records into sound
photography (n)	the use of light to <b>record</b> an image using a camera
seismograph (n)	a device that <b>writes</b> down (records) the movements of the earth

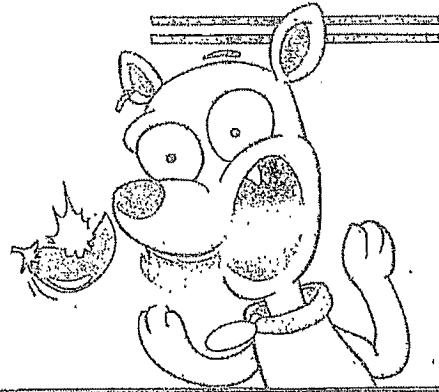
